

THE RACHEL REICHNER EXCELLENCE IN SCOUTING SCHOLARSHIP 2023 INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

Eligibility Requirements:

- Aged 17-25
- Been a member of a Scouting program during high school.
- Enrolled or accepted into a post-secondary school for Fall 2023.
- Previous applicants may apply for the scholarship. Past scholarship recipients are not eligible to reapply.

Evaluation Criteria:

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide high achieving Scouts financial assistance towards post-secondary school education. This is a non-academic award and is based on leadership and achievements in the Scouting program. Do not include your academic achievements or transcript as this will disqualify your application.

Scholarship Fund Disbursement:

The scholarship amount will be determined by The 37 Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee. The scholarship award will be payable to the recipient. The 37 Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee will choose the number of recipients and the amount of the scholarship awards. The scholarship award amount likely will range between \$500 and \$2,500. Recipients will be required to submit a scholarship acceptance agreement, digital picture and thank you note before the scholarship award is disbursed. Failure to do so in a timely manner may result in forfeiture of the scholarship award.

Required materials must be **postmarked** by May 31, 2023, but applicants are encouraged not to wait until the last minute. **Applications sent by priority or overnight mail will not be accepted if sent after May 25.** Incomplete, late, or electronic submissions will not be accepted. Please note on the application form that you have attached additional pages to answer the question. Please clearly note which question you are answering on the additional pages.
- Two Letters of Recommendation (only two will be accepted)
- Essays as directed in the application
- Copy of acceptance letter from the post-secondary school for Fall 2023 or Certification of Enrollment in a post-secondary school

 - ii. Describe how you use a specific skill developed in Scouting in your daily life and how you expect to use that skill in your future.
 - iii. How have your Scouting experiences helped you to overcome a great obstacle?
 - iv. What obstacles did you overcome to be part of Scouting?
 - v. What was the most significant challenge you faced as a leader in Scouting? How did you handle the situation? Would you handle the situation any differently now?
